Hello **explorer!** Ready for an unforgettable journey to Corcovado National Park?

Let us guide you through the reservation process.

Important details for the best experience:

- Corcovado's natural wonders come with some essential logistics. To secure your spot, we will need your passport number and full name to check availability—this is due to national park regulations.
- The reservation involves **three steps**, and while it may feel a bit old-school, we're here to make it as smooth as possible:
 1. **Park Fees** – You'll receive a secure PayPal link for this payment.
 2. **Lodging & Meals** – The organization handling your lodging and meals (ADI) will email you an authorization form. You will print, fill it out and send it back to ADI with the necessary information and don't worry—we'll assist you through this.
 3. **Final Payment in Cash** – This is for your guide and will be made in Costa Rica when your adventure begins.
- Once we start with the reservation process we just have 24 hours to make the payments for park fees, lodging and meals. Yes, the process is a bit of an adventure in itself, but trust us, once you step into Corcovado's wild beauty, it will all be worth it!

- Which entrance to Corcovado would you like to explore? (Sirena, La Leona, El Tigre).
